Great results from Parent/Carer Questionnaire: Thank you!



Governors are delighted to report some of the best Parent/Carer Questionnaire results for some time.

We decided to use QR Codes during the spring term Parents' Evenings this year, in the hope we would receive even more responses. We received 145 completed questionnaires this year which is an increase on 2023 results. We are keen to receive even more

completed questionnaires so if you have any suggestions for how we can make it even more accessible/ easy to complete please do let us know.

Our results included:

- **99% strongly agree or agree that their children feel safe at school**
- **98% strongly agree or agree that their children are supported with their mental health and well being at school**
- **97% of children enjoy coming to school**
- **96% of parents/carers with children with special needs, strongly agree or agree that the school gives them the support they need to succeed**
- **More than 96% strongly agree or agree that the school is welcoming and inclusive of all pupils, parents and carers**
- **95% strongly agree or agree that the school lets parents/carers know how their child is doing**
- **94% strongly agree or agree that the school celebrate diversity through the curriculum, assemblies, special events and visitors**
- **93% have either never had to complain or strongly agree or agree that the school responds to complaints effectively**
- **93% strongly agree or agree that school listens to and respects parents and carers.**

We are delighted with these results especially as there has been progress with areas that we agreed to improve in 2023.

- don't have to have a connection to the school
- should have the skills and experience required to contribute to the effective governance and success of the school
- come from the Hagley Primary School community and know the needs of the community well
- reflect the diverse community they serve
- contribute to the diverse range of views to support robust decision making
- will act in the best interests of the school and the wider community.

Of 42 comments 15 were positive including: "I cannot thank you enough for all your hard work and dedication to help make Hagley Primary School such a caring, nurturing and inclusive school." Leaders are committed to continuing to review and improve communication with parents/carers (89% strongly agree or agree that school communicates well with parents/carers) and how parents/carers are informed about what their child will be doing throughout the year (91% strongly agree or agree). Governors will also continue reviewing the enrichment opportunities available (91% strongly agree or agree).



Huge thanks to all the staff at Hagley Primary School for all their continued hard work this year. It will be another exciting, busy and rewarding half term and Governors are extremely grateful to the entire the staff team for their hardwork, dedication and commitment to Hagley Primary School pupils throughout the year.
