CONGRATULATIONS to both teams! We look forward to returning with our pupils next year to defend our title.



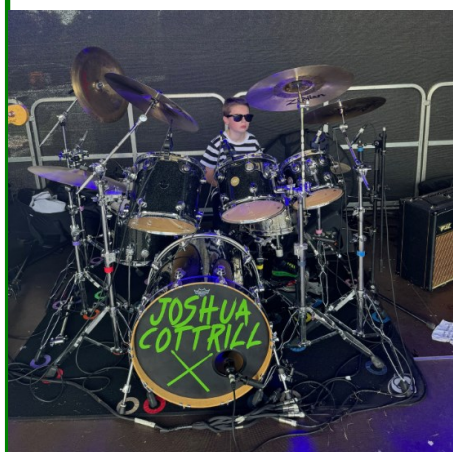
Matilda Performance
