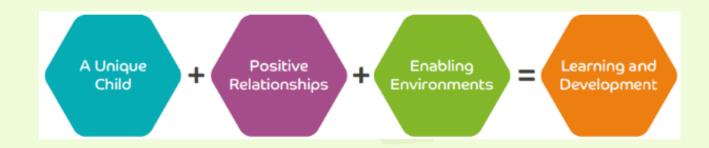




### The Early Years Foundation Stage

## End of the Day Routine

HAGLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL

- Children gather belongings and wait in classrooms
- 2:55pm Collect your child from the external door of their classroom
- Gates open just before 2:55pm
- Collect from Reception before KS1 and KS2
- Only **named adults** on collection form can collect your child (For alternative arrangements please contact the school office)
- After school club pick up from the internal classroom doors



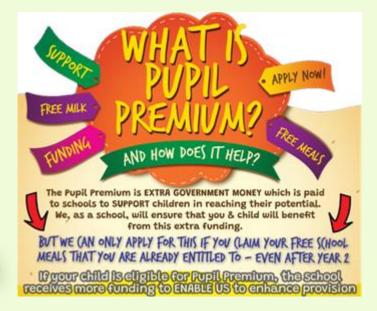






### New Starter Forms

### Food and drink

- Named water bottle (sports cap)
- Snack time:
  - Milk free until child's 5<sup>th</sup> birthday then payable via Cool Milk
  - Fruit a free piece of fruit every day

#### Lunch time:

Free school meals for all Reception and KS1 children

- Please choose your child's meals from the menu via parent-pay
- Must be chosen online by 4pm Tuesday the week before
- Please let us know any dietary requirements before your child starts
- Packed lunch healthy eating policy and 'nut free' zone











### Health

- Staff need to be aware of your child's medical background allergies, asthma, eczema, dietary restrictions etc.
- Contact details there must be someone **contactable during the day** in case of emergencies
- Please keep us up to date with changes to medical needs and contact details
- If your child is absent please confirm with the school office each day

#### Language Link

- Online screening tool used to screen all reception children in Autumn Term
- Supports to identify language gaps and children who need 1:1 or group intervention
- Helps to identify children who may need referral to NHS Speech and Language Therapist



#### **Individual Provision Map**

- If children need additional support with learning we may introduce an IPM (with your consent)
- Targets will be set to support any difficulties or gaps in learning.
- These will be mostly addressed in class but may also involve some intervention
- Liaise with External Professionals Educational Psychologist, Learning Support, Occupational Therapist, Complex, Communication Needs Team etc

#### Thrive / Wellbeing

- We are a Thrive School of excellence and prioritise supporting children's well being
- All classes have a whole class target and weekly Thrive session based on the class needs
- Some children may need 1:1 or group intervention. For example, to support emotional resilience / regulation or to support with life events like bereavement or separation
- We offer a wide range of wellbeing support also including Pet Therapy and Thrive Forest School.



## Getting Ready for School - NHS advice

#### Sleep:

- Bedtime routine
- Off electronic devices 1 hour before bedtime
- 10.5-11.5 hours sleep recommended a night

#### Self-care:

- Wear pants and know when they need the toilet
- Dress and undress themselves
- Practise going to the toilet, zips and buttons







#### Speech and language:

- Talk in sentences that other people can understand
- Enjoy stories, nursery rhymes and conversation

#### **Eating:**

- Open food packets
- Use a knife, fork and spoon

Long hair tied back – boys and girls No nail varnish or temporary tattoos One ear stud

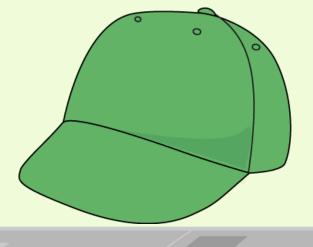
Fleeces do not replace school uniform
