


Nursery News



Our Story Adventures



This week, we have been exploring “The Ugly Duckling” and “Love Makes a Family”. Both stories helped us think about belonging and feeling loved. The children shared ideas about what makes them happy or sad, and thought of different ways we can show love and kindness.

Love Bread and Caring for Others

One special way we showed love this week was by making our very own Love Bread to take home and share with our families. The children practised talking through the steps, working together, and showing care for others.



We also welcomed Groot the tortoise into nursery and thought about how we show love and care for pets. This linked beautifully to our new ‘Vet Imagination Station’, where the children have been busy caring for animals through role-play.



Creative Autumn Play

Outdoors and indoors, the children have enjoyed making mud pies, exploring autumn playdough, and even shooting conkers down drainpipes with water! These activities encouraged creativity, problem-solving, and teamwork while exploring the natural world.

Maths in Action

In maths, we have been creating collections with large and small amounts and talking about how they compare. Children made natural collections and noticed collections that are large, small or the same.

Super Communicators

We are so proud of our super communicators this week. The children have shared stories about their own pets — real or imaginary — and listened carefully to their friends’ ideas. They have also enjoyed retelling the story of “The Ugly Duckling” with actions and their own words, showing confidence in sequencing and storytelling.

In play, the children have been practising their communication skills further by negotiating roles, sharing resources and playing cooperatively — whether in the ‘Vet Imagination Station’ or during outdoor adventures.
