


Mini Me


Play Adventures

Maths- Counting and Subitising

Maths has been full of magic this week! We've been counting to 5 using our fingers, dice, and dominoes, and playing "Show Me" games— "Show me 3... show me 5!" We've been spotting numbers everywhere and creating our own magic show by showing and hiding amounts of 1, 2 and 3.



Songs like "One Potato, Two Potato" have helped us practise counting in playful ways that make maths feel like magic.
