Year 2 children who do not meet the phonics standard will have opportunity to join appropriate groups of YI children to recap sounds and teach any gaps they may have.

Year 2 children who meet the phonics standard, but are identified as still having some difficulties with phonics will receive interventions with other Y2 children. They will also continue going to phonics lessons in Year I, matching their book band. These are often the children who either only just passed the phonics screening check, or children who may benefit from further consolidation.

Any children who still do not meet the phonics screening standard at the end of Year 2 will receive targeted and bespoke intervention in Year 3.
