

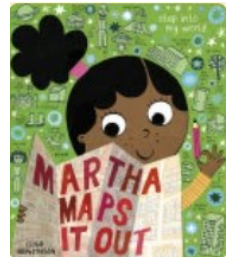


Reception News

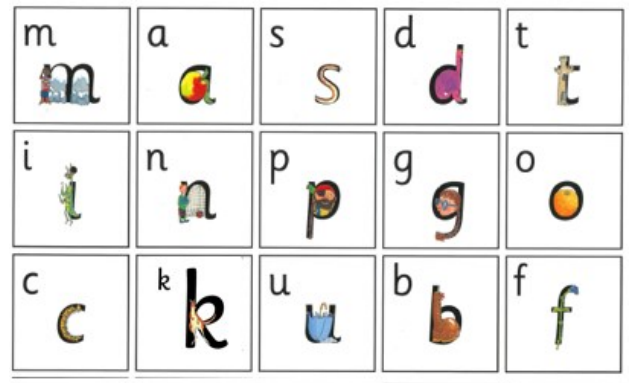
Maths



This week we have been talking about size, capacity and mass. We have looked at different containers and compared how much they hold, and have compared 2 different items in balance scales, using the words heavier and lighter. We have looked at small quantities of objects and used the words 'more than' and 'fewer than' to describe the difference between them.

Phonics

We have now had 3 weeks of learning single letter sounds, and practising these at home with your child will really help to ensure they are embedded. Your child should be saying the sound the letter makes, not the letter name. They may use the rhymes associated with each letter to help them remember the letter sound.
