Set 1 sounds are taught in Nursery and in Reception.

All of the Read Write Inc. sounds have a 'ditty' to help make them more memorable for the children.

Fore example, /m/ is mmmmm-Maisie mountain, mountain and 'thing on a string in /ng/.


























Set 1 single letter sounds are taught in Nursery and Reception. It is essential that he children learn the single letter sounds clearly and accurately in order to blend them into words. We need to teach pure sounds. Click the link to watch a video about pure sounds:
