

## Set 2 sounds



Set 2 Sounds are taught in Reception when single letters are secure, and recapped at the beginning of Year 1. As most children begin Year 1, they will be familiar with the Set 2 sounds. They know 2 letters make 1 sound and find them in words.

They also have a 'ditty' and picture assigned to them to make them memorable for the children. For example, 'ay' is 'May I Play?' and 'fly high' is igh.

Children will learn to read them in both real, and 'nonsense' (alien) words to prepare them for the Phonics Screening Check at the end of Year 1.
