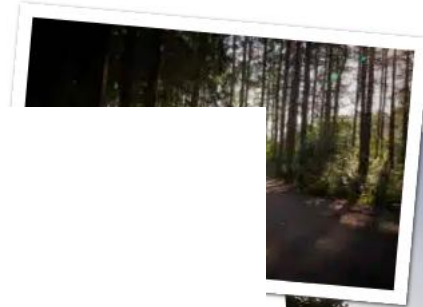

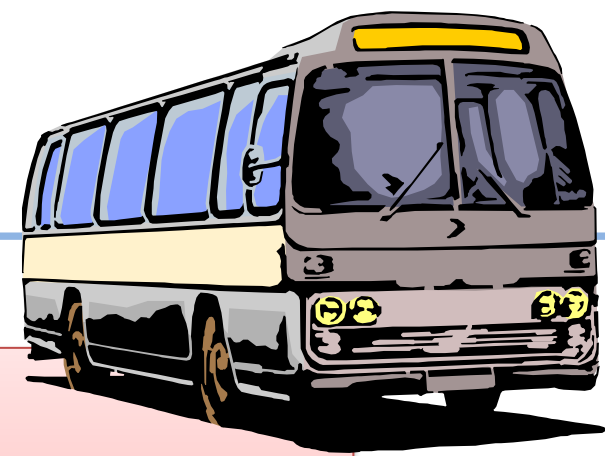

ACCOMMODATION



Children will be asked to write down up to 5 children they would like to be in a dorm with. We will make sure they are with at least one of those friends.

CLOTHING

Clothes are likely to suffer wear and tear and also get dirty and/or wet therefore you should bring several changes of old clothes for doing activities.

MONEY AND VALUABLES

THE CHILDREN MAY TAKE:

- Maximum of £5 pocket money – clearly marked purse or wallet (hand to class teacher on the Monday morning).
- Children may take a disposable camera – clearly named (these are collected each night).

PLEASE DO NOT SEND:

Any valuable items including **MOBILE PHONES.**

The children will not have time to use these items and their safety cannot be guaranteed.

FOOD

There is lots of choice available for each meal, including a vegetarian option and a salad bar.

Three meals a day are provided. There is such a good choice of food that nobody will go hungry! More food is always available if required.

Special dietary needs are catered for and children can check what is available for them to eat using the notice board.



Special diets, including food allergies (nuts etc.) should be notified on the medical form.

MEDICAL MATTERS

- If your child is asthmatic, could you please make sure that they bring **2 inhalers** (clearly labelled).
- Please complete all of the medical forms in the pack you will receive and ensure that any particular needs are clearly indicated.
- Please confirm whether you consent for your child to be administered Piriton and/or Calpol.
- On the morning of our departure, please hand any medication to:

Mr Tindell (coach 1) or Miss Schuck (coach 2)

- A letter of notification advising which coach your child will be on will be sent out at least one week prior to departure.

COMMUNICATIONS

Again, we request that the children DO NOT take mobile phones due to risk of loss or damage. Staff will be in contact with the school daily.

If any parents need to contact us in an emergency, please call the school. We will have contact details for all children and we will contact you if we need to.

In an absolute emergency outside of school hours, please contact the Boreatton Park office and a member of staff will get a message to us.

INSURANCE

Standard insurance:

- Your child is insured to travel to and from the PGL site and for all of the activities which they will be taking part in.
- They are covered under the school's insurance for the journey to and from Boreatton Park as with any school trip.
- Once the children arrive at the centre, they are covered by the PGL insurance, which is included in the cost of the trip.
