

Maths

In maths this week, we have been exploring **1 and 1 more makes 2** through practical play and group learning.

We have also been using lots of **positional language** as we followed Rosie's route and talked about where she went in the story.

Writing and Mark Making

In writing, we have been practising **wiggly lines** as we mapped Rosie's route.

Some children have also started to form shapes and marks to write their **names!**

LittleLink - Negative Language

This week we explored the idea that Ben could **not** keep Teddy because Teddy was **not** his, helping the children build understanding of negative language through stories and discussion. We talked about that parents sometimes say "No."
