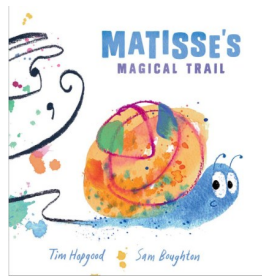
Friday 13th March
